SOFT LANDSCAPE

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STREET TREES
Native specimen Street trees,
e.g. Sorbus aucuparia, 14-16cm girth
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TREES IN PARKLAND
Mix of native & Non-native trees in 3 sizes Quercus robur (14-16cm girth) , girth Betula Pendula(18-20cm girth), Prunus serotina Fugenzio (10-12cm girth)
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WOODLAND MIX
Mix of native 12-14cm trees & Whips: 20% Hazel/Crab/Rowan/Oak 10%Birch/Pine
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HERBACIOUS BORDER
Mixed planting edge, e.g Alchemilla vulgaris, Ajuga reptans, Vinca minor alba
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HEDGEROW(EXISTING)
Existing hedgerows retained and gaps supplemented with site native species on site, e.g crataegus monogyna
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SUDS
Mix of wet & dry tolerant Perennial grasses, flowers & shrubs at 7 per m2
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MEADOW GROUND MIX
Naturalised area with topsoil left to self seed.
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LAWN
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
Native Woodland Area
Native tree plantation with amenity space circulating throughout the woodland


SURFACE MATERIALS

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PATHWAYS
Brushed concrete, build up to engineers spec.
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FUTURE CONNECTIONS
Resin bound gravel with granite paving setts
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DRIVEWAYS
Two tone concrete permeable paving
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PATHWAYS IN LANDSCAPED AREAS
1.8m wide Ballylusk gravel,
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PAVING ' MATTS ' IN LANDSCAPED AREAS
Two tone concrete paving with exposed stone chip

SITE ELEMENTS

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FORMAL PLAY (indicative)
Robinia wood structures with woodchip safety surface
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NATURAL PLAYFEATURES
Inc play boulders, felled tree & stepping stones
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LIGHTING
Lighting locations marked in plan
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SEATING
Cast-in-situ concrete benches with wooden top
